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Who are the youth forum?

We are a representative group of young people from Northern Ireland, aged 16 – 24 years old who have been affected by cancer. We share our experience about cancer (if we feel comfortable), and how our lives have been affected by it. We meet regularly and also attend local conferences, events and network with other groups, decision makers and those in a position of influence to raise awareness of the impact of cancer on us.

Why get involved?

We meet to discuss issues we have encountered before, during and after treatment. We research the latest information and services available to young people affected by cancer in Northern Ireland and beyond. We provide feedback on these issues and on the work of CLIC Sargent Youth Service, supporting staff to provide quality, researched and user-friendly information for young people. Using our experience, skills and knowledge in these areas, we aim to provide all young people affected by cancer with a means to access information, support and a way to communicate with each other and the wider world as it can be a lonely experience, especially when you are in hospital. We also want to share and listen to other young people's views across Northern Ireland and beyond on cancer related issues.

How can I join?

You can join us if you have been affected by cancer and are aged 16 – 24 and living in Northern Ireland. We are happy for you to attend a meeting to see what we do. After that a commitment is required to become a full member and we provide ongoing training to ensure you get the most from your time. We also have a good laugh and sometimes go for pizza afterwards! Many of us meet in between meetings and it's a great way to make new friends. **Come and join us!**
