

## Questions to ask your consultant

Some young people have helped us put together a list of *"I wish I'd asked that"* questions, which may help you make the most of your meeting with the consultant.

### I wish I'd asked that!

1. What are my chances of getting better?
2. How many other young people have this type of cancer?
3. Why did I get this cancer and why now?
4. What is the best treatment for cancer for people like me?
5. Where can I get this treatment?
6. How long will my treatment last?
7. How long will I have to stay in hospital for?
8. Will the treatment hurt?
9. What am I not going to be able to do?
10. I've got a school trip/holiday booked – can I still go?
11. Will I still be able to go out with my friends/go to school?
12. Will I be able to have children?

And you can ask the consultant to put everything in writing for you!
