What is the purpose of the role?

What does it involve?

Forming a group of enthusiastic and motivated individuals with a passion for making a difference to the lives of children with cancer.
Organising fundraising events and activities in your community to raise vital funds (plenty of support, ideas and resources will be available from your local Community Fundraising Manager).
Raising the profile of CLIC Sargent in your local area. Using existing local contacts, such as family and friends, and developing new contacts to expand your group.

What skills or experience do I need?

The passion and drive to help children with cancer and their families.
A creative and organised approach to putting on events and activities in your local area.

What can I expect from the role?

Don't worry if you haven't formed a group like this before! CLIC Sargent will provide you with all the information, advice, ideas, resources and training you'll need to get going.
You will receive a full induction in person from the Community Fundraising Manager, followed by help and support with your events throughout the year. The local Community Fundraising Manager will remain in regular contact with you by phone and e-mail, and is anticipated to visit groups at least twice a year.
You'll definitely have fun, make new friends, and learn new skills!

Availability

The role is flexible - you can give as much or as little time as you are able and you can volunteer at times that suit you.

Location

Shetland, based at home but committee meetings can be organised elsewhere. Community Fundraising Manager will be in regular contact and visit group as often as possible.

Out of pocket expenses will be reimbursed.
