What is the purpose of the role?

To source prizes to be used at CLIC Sargent raffles, auctions and fundraising events

What does it involve?

Contacting businesses in specified areas to see if they would donate prizes that the Charity could use in its fundraising activities  
Contact could be by telephone, letter or in person  
Maintaining a log of people contacted and their response  
Using existing local contacts, such as family and friends, to source prizes

What skills or experience do I need?

The passion and drive to help children with cancer and their families  
A personable and friendly manner in person and a confident, cheerful telephone manner

What can I expect from the role?

Full induction to the charity and training for the role will be provided before you begin  
You'll gain insight into the work of CLIC Sargent in supporting children with cancer and their families  
The satisfaction of knowing that you are contributing to the Charity's fundraising efforts, and ultimately helping CLIC Sargent to be there for more children and families affected by cancer
