Bristol 10K Race Marshal

What is the purpose of the role?

To help marshal the Bristol 10K, alongside a team of volunteer marshals

What does it involve?

- Manning the course, making sure the runners are heading the right way
- Making sure members of the public do not go onto the course and the route is clear
- Making sure the race goes smoothly
- Getting a prime view of the race!
- Encouraging runners

What skills or experience do I need?

- No experience necessary – you will receive an information pack prior to the event and a full briefing on the day
- You will need to be able to keep calm in difficult situations and be willing to stay in your position outdoors, come rain or shine, for the duration of the race

What can I expect from the role?

- A fantastic day out with a great view of the race
- You will play a key role in one of the UK's largest 10K races
- You will help to raise vital funds to help us support children with cancer - without CLIC Sargent marshals, we would not have this great partnership with the Bristol 10K
