Publications Review Panel Member

What is the purpose of the role?

To review CLIC Sargent publications for young people and their families to make sure they are appropriate for the target audience.

What does it involve?

Reading and reviewing a CLIC Sargent publication (eg a booklet), or piece of material (eg a few pages of our website) approximately three times a year
Completing a feedback form asking for reviewers' feedback about how useful the information is, how easy it is to understand, tone, presentation and graphics
Emailing the feedback form back to the Information Manager within two weeks of receiving the item for review.

What skills or experience do I need?

You need to have been affected by childhood cancer. You could be
A young person who is being treated for cancer, or who has finished treatment
The sibling of a child or young person who has/had cancer
The parent of a child or young person who has/had cancer
We are also looking for teachers, to review our material for schools; you don't need to have experience of supporting a child with cancer.
You will need to have access to email as all correspondence will be done electronically.

What can I expect from the role?

Experience of sitting on a formal Publications Review Panel which you can include on your CV or an application for study/work
Your feedback to be valued and taken into account by CLIC Sargent when updating/producing information material; we will let you know how your feedback has been used

Availability

Approximately three times a year for two hours at a time.

Location

At home – all communication will be by email.

Expenses

There should not be any out of pocket expenses as this role can be completed from home and will be carried out via email. However, if there is a need for you to post anything to CLIC Sargent the cost of this will be reimbursed.
