

How your money helps

Every day 10 children and young people hear the shocking news they have cancer. CLIC Sargent provides clinical, practical and emotional support to help them cope with cancer and get the most out of life.

Here's how your donation or the sponsorship money you raise could make a real difference:

£2.50 could pay for a copy of CLIC Sargent's magazine *Shout Out!* for children age seven to 13 - supporting them during and after treatment and helping them feel less isolated.

£4 could pay for one copy of a CLIC Sargent storybook that explains childhood cancer in simple, easy to understand language - putting cancer into words and illustrations children can relate to. These are an important way of helping children understand what's happening to them.

£8 could pay for a copy of *What now?* CLIC Sargent's new booklet to help parents and carers whose child has just been diagnosed with cancer to understand how it may affect them.

£15 could pay for a copy of CLIC Sargent's DVD to help families where a child or young person has died of cancer to understand and cope with their grief.

£33 could pay for a family to stay overnight in one of CLIC Sargent's Homes from Home, providing free self-catering accommodation near to specialist children's cancer treatment centres, which are often many miles from a family's own home. Staying in a Home from Home ensures a family can be close to their child during treatment. The atmosphere in a Home from Home is friendly and welcoming. If they are well enough, the child or young person can stay there too.

£170 could pay for a CLIC Sargent grant. Cancer can have a huge effect on a family's finances and a CLIC Sargent grant is offered to children and young people with cancer, and their families, as soon as they come into contact with us to help meet the sudden extra costs that a cancer diagnosis can bring.

£230 could pay for a family to stay in a CLIC Sargent Home from Home for a week.

£300 could fund a CLIC Sargent Compassionate Grant to help a bereaved family pay for their child's funeral.

£430 could fund CLIC Sargent's Information Service for one day, so that we can provide children and young people with cancer, and their families, with vital information about childhood cancer to help them cope with the impact of cancer on their lives.

£990 could pay for a family to stay for a month in a CLIC Sargent Home from Home.

£12,571 could pay for a year's supply of *What now?*

£71,000 could fund our volunteer programme for a year. CLIC Sargent simply could not support children and young people with cancer, and their families, without the fantastic support of thousands of volunteers who commit their time and expertise in a huge number of roles across the charity.

£112,000 could fund our Information Service for a year.

£850,000 could fund the running costs for a year for CLIC Sargent's Homes from Home service, to enable families to stay near their children for free during cancer treatment.

£1.1 million could fund our grants service for a year.

CLIC Sargent care professionals

CLIC Sargent Play Specialists

£15 could pay for one hour of a CLIC Sargent Play Specialist's time, so that they can help a child prepare for and cope with treatment, by using models, toys and photos to explain what will happen.

£114 could pay for a CLIC Sargent Play Specialist for a day.

£570 could pay for a CLIC Sargent Play Specialist for a week.

£2,275 could pay for a CLIC Sargent Play Specialist for a month.

£30,000 could pay for a CLIC Sargent Play Specialist for a year.

£821 could pay for a CLIC Sargent Social Worker for a week.

£3,557 could pay for a CLIC Sargent Social Worker for a month.

£43,000 could pay for a CLIC Sargent Social Worker for a year.

CLIC Sargent Nurses

£28 could pay for an hour of a CLIC Sargent Nurse's time, so that they can coordinate clinical and non-clinical care for children with cancer, to maximise the amount of time they can safely spend at home, and ensure that treatments can be given closer to home where possible.

£210 could pay for a CLIC Sargent Nurse for a day.

£1051 could pay for a CLIC Sargent Nurse for a week.

£4,246 could pay for a CLIC Sargent Nurse for a month.

£55,000 could pay for a CLIC Sargent Nurse for a year.

CLIC Sargent Social Workers

£23 could pay for an hour of a CLIC Sargent Social Worker's time. They will aim to meet children and young people with cancer, and their families, soon after diagnosis and help them to understand and cope with the emotional, practical and financial effects of cancer, through treatment and beyond.

£164 could pay for a CLIC Sargent Social Worker for a day.
