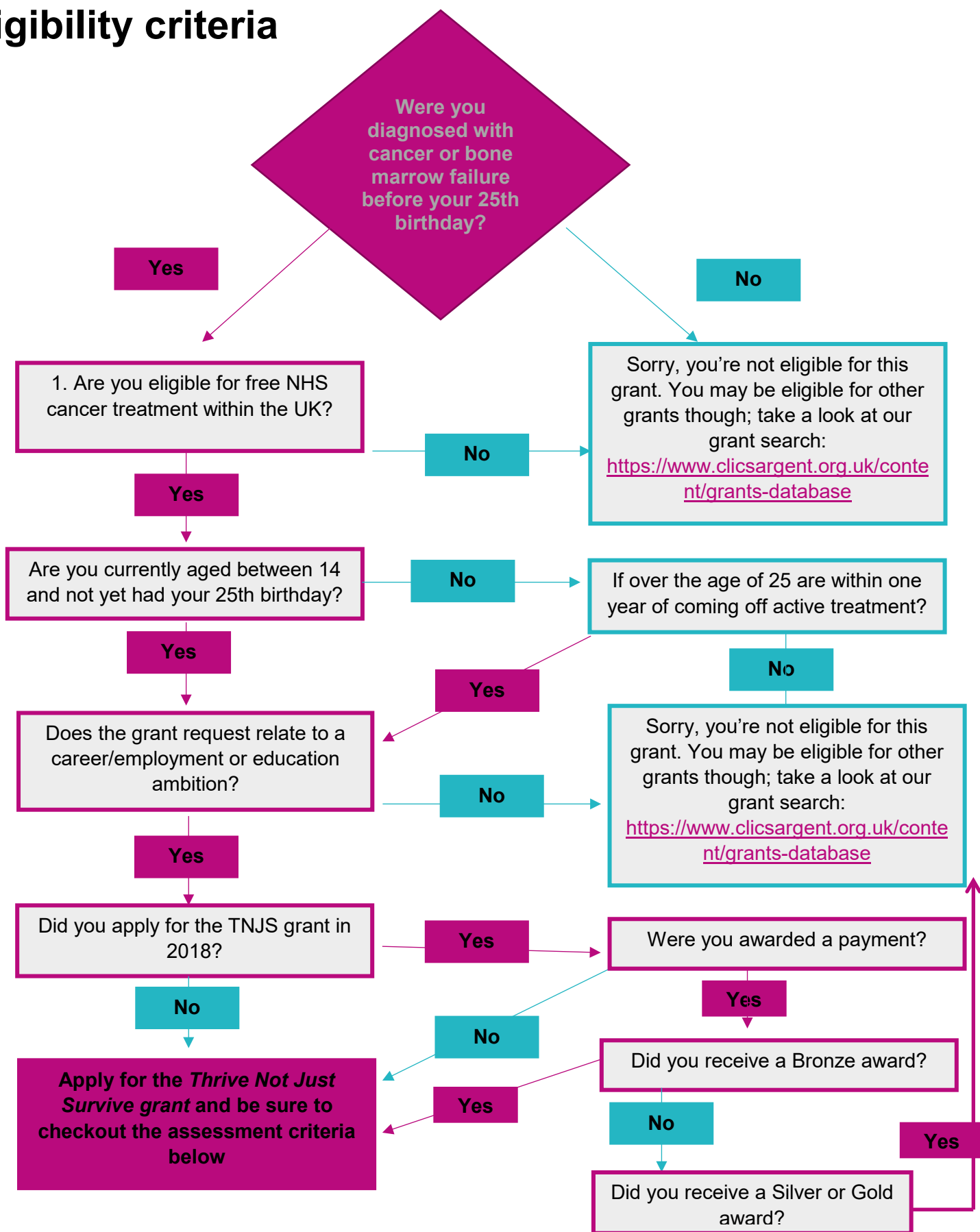


THRIVE NOT JUST SURVIVE GRANT CHECKLIST

Question	Assessment criteria
1. What is your goal or ambition?	<p>3 - Exceeds criteria: application thoroughly demonstrates their goal/ambition. The goal has a clear educational or employability outcome.</p> <p>2- Meets criteria: application demonstrates goal/ambition and there appears to be a link to education or employment. There are minor gaps in explanation and clarity.</p> <p>1- Does not meet criteria: application has minimal information on the goal/ambition. The goal/ambition does not have a clear educational or employability outcome.</p>
2. How will the grant help you to achieve this goal?	<p>3 – Exceeds criteria: there are clear plans to achieve the goal/ambition. Application provides details of exactly what the grant will be used for, what success looks like, when it will be achieved and the difference this grant will make on achieving the goal/ambition.</p> <p>2 – Meets criteria: application demonstrates plans to achieve the goal/ambition. There are minor gaps in explanation and clarity. Application provides some detail on what the grant will be spent on, what success looks like, when it will be achieved and the difference this grant will make on achieving the goal/ambition. There are some minor gaps and questions the panel have on how the grant would be spent in order to support the young person achieving their goal/ambition.</p> <p>1 – Does not meet criteria: There is limited or no plans in place to achieve the goal/ambition. The application has minimal information to show the how the grant will actually help the young person achieve the goal/ambition. What success looks like is unclear. It is also unclear as to how the money will be spent, what it will be used for and how this links to the goal/ambition.</p>
3. How has your illness affected you in trying to achieve your ambition?	<p>3 - Exceeds criteria: thoroughly demonstrates the impact cancer has had on the young person; there is no doubt that cancer has either altered the goal/ambition or delayed the young person from achieving it.</p> <p>2- Meets criteria: application provides some detail on how the young person's cancer has impacted on their goal/ambition. There are some minor gaps and questions the panel have on whether the goal/ambition has altered or been delayed because of the young</p>

person's cancer but nothing significant.

4. How have you worked towards this ambition so far?

1- Does not meet criteria: application has minimal information to show the impact of the young person's cancer diagnosis on their goal/ambition. It is unclear as to whether the goal/ambition has been affected by the young person's cancer diagnosis or something else.

3 – Exceeds criteria: provides details of exactly what the young person has already done to try to achieve this goal/ambition

2- Meets criteria: provides some detail on what the young person has already done to try to achieve this goal/ambition

1 – Does not meet criteria: there is little or no evidence that the young person has investigated other ways of achieving their goal/ambition.

5. Have you applied for any other funding? (Please list)

3 - Exceeds criteria: details given of other funding routes that have been explored.

2- Meets criteria: provides limited details around other funding routes that have been explored.

1- Does not meet criteria: application has minimal information on other funding routes explored.
